Subject: Notification of Removal from Continuing Noncompliance Status

Dear Dr. Peña:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify Hutto ISD (herein referred to as the local educational agency or “LEA”) that it has completed the corrective action plan required by the cyclical desk review conducted by the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

On August 4, 2023, TEA notified the LEA of continuing noncompliance status when it did not complete its corrective action plan in the following areas within a calendar year.

- Transition: Courses of Study  
34 CFR §300.320(b)(2)
- Transition: Transfer of Rights by 17  
19 TAC §89.1049(a)

The LEA was required to submit documentation to TEA demonstrating the completion of the corrective action plan and the resolution of the continuing noncompliance noted above. The LEA’s documentation indicates that the corrective action plan has been completed and that the status of continuing noncompliance has been resolved. No further action on this issue is required.
