Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Dr. Jose Moreno:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Somerset Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Somerset ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 4/29/2022 listing the following area(s) of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Present Levels of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance
34 CFR §300.320(a)(1)
- Transition: Measurable Postsecondary Goals
34 CFR §300.320(b); 19 TAC §89.1055(I)(1)

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the issues of noncompliance noted above. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that these areas of noncompliance have been addressed and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on this issue is required at this time.
