- The number of children whose eligibility was determined within the required number of calendar days after evaluation

In addition, this report displays the sums and percentages for the range of days past the initial evaluation due date and for each delay reason category.

## **SPPI-11 Student Compliance Report** (CHF0-100-001)

### **Report Description**

The SPPI-11 Student Compliance Report lists each child between ages 3-21 with an eligibility determination date during the current reporting period (July 1 - June 30). This report does not include children identified for SPPI-12.

The SPPI-11 Student Compliance report indicates the compliance status for both the Full Individual and Initial Evaluation (FIIE) and the eligibility determination. FIIE compliance is based on completing the evaluation within the required timeframe after the local education agency (LEA) receives written parental consent. Eligibility determination compliance is based on the date on which a child's eligibility for special education is determined. Timeframe requirements vary based factors such as the number of instructional days remaining in the school year after parental consent for the initial evaluation was received, the number of student absences, and whether or not the 30th calendar day for the eligibility determination timeframe falls during the summer.
