- The Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) formula grant programs
- Free appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment
- Part B (3-21) and Part C (birth-3) TSDS Child Find collection

- State Performance Plan / Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR)
 - Developed every six years
 - Submitted annually
- Data collected on 17 indicators
 - Performance or compliance based


Child Find Compliance Indicators

- Compliance indicators included in the Child Find Collection
 - SPPI 11A: Timely Initial Evaluation - compliance with required timeframe for evaluating children for Part B, special education
 - SPPI 11B: Eligibility Determination
 - SPPI 12: Early Childhood Transition - compliance with timely transition from Early Childhood Intervention (ECI) under Part C to Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) for Part B
- Compliance target for both indicators is 100%



SPPI 11A/B:

Initial Evaluation/Eligibility Determination

- Children aged 3-21 (includes students who were not referred by ECI)
- Children in ECI less than 90 calendar days before their 3rd birthday
 - ORIGINAL-ECI-SERVICES-DATE (E1737)
- Eligibility Determination (ED) between July 1 and June 30
 - Enrolled and non-enrolled children

SPPI 12:

Early Childhood Transition


- Children in ECI 90 calendar days or more before their 3rd birthday
 - ORIGINAL-ECI-SERVICES-DATE (E1737)
- Eligibility Determination (ED) between July 1 and June 30
 - Enrolled and non-enrolled children

TSDS Instructional Calendar Data Maintenance

- Ensure all campus instructional calendars are uploaded and current
- Update campus instructional calendars to reflect changes during the year (bad weather days, etc.)
- For “carry-over” students: TSDS will pull prior-year campus instructional calendar from PEIMS submission




SPPI-11A Results 2022 and 2023

SPPI-11A Compliance Percentage




SPPI-11B Results 2022 and 2023


SPPI 11: Measurement

State Performance Plan Indicator (SPPI) 11 measures the percent of children who were evaluated within 60 days of receiving parental consent for initial evaluation or, if the State establishes a timeframe within which the evaluation must be conducted, within that timeframe. Texas establishes a state timeline in [Texas Administrative Code §89.1011](#).

The ECI program shall include the date the child enrolled for Part C services, if applicable, in the notification sent to the LEA informing them of a child potentially eligible for early childhood special education services under Part B of IDEA.

- September 11, 2023: LEAs able to promote data
 - SPED-ELIGIBILITY-DETERMINATION-DATE (E1716) between July 1, 2023, and June 30, 2024
- October 5, 2023: [TAA letter](#) published
- May 20, 2024: Child Find submission starts
- July 25, 2024, at 11:59 PM: Child Find submission deadline
