The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Bakerripley Community Schools of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Bakerripley Community Schools received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 01/31/25 listing the following area(s) of noncompliance:
