The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Carrollton Farmers Branch Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Carrollton Farmers Branch ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 7/27/2023 listing the following area(s) of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: 34 CFR §300.320(a)(2)(i)
- Properly Constituted ARD: 19 TAC §89.1050(c)(1)(I)
- Properly Constituted ARD: 34 CFR §300.322(d); 19 TAC §89.1050(d)

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the abovementioned noncompliance. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that this area of noncompliance has been addressed, and the noncompliance has been corrected.
