- In an effort to increase the number of Educational Diagnosticians and Licensed Specialists in School Psychology (LSSPs) in small and rural schools in Texas, TEA, in collaboration with the Small and Rural Schools Network, provides approved applicants in an applicable course of study at an accredited university financial reimbursement for eligible program costs. Applicants must sign an agreement to provide a minimum of 3 years of evaluation services in a small and/or rural LEA or SSA.



The first application deadline for the [Evaluation Certification Reimbursement Program](#) is October 19, 2020.
