Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Dr. Don Beck:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Marion Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the **Cyclical Desk Review**.

Marion ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 4/30/2024 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Measurable Goals
34 Code of Federal Regulations §300.320(a)(2)
- Transition: Parent Involvement
19 Texasc Administration Code §89.1055(h)(2); Texas Education Code § 29.011(a); TEC §29.0111
- Transition: Agency Consideration
19 TAC § 89.1055(h)(9); TEC § 29.011(a)(9)

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the abovementioned noncompliance. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that this area of noncompliance has been addressed, and the noncompliance has been corrected.
