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Other Special Populations (OSP) Results Driven Accountability (RDA) Indicators 2023-2024

Indicator #1 (i-v) OSP STAAR 3-8 Passing Rate (PL Assignment)

Measures the percent of students in Foster Care, experiencing homelessness, or Military- Connected (OSP) students who met the minimum level of satisfactory performance or higher on the STAAR 3-8 assessments.

Indicator #2 OSP Dyslexia STAAR 3-8 Reading Language Arts Passing Rate (Report Only - No PL Assigned)

Measures the percent of students in Foster Care, experiencing homelessness, or Military- Connected (OSP) students who are also identified with dyslexia and met the minimum level of satisfactory performance or higher on the STAAR 3-8 Reading Language Arts assessment.

Indicator #3 (i-iv) OSP STAAR EOC Passing Rate (PL Assignment)

Measures the percent of students in Foster Care, experiencing homelessness, or Military- Connected (OSP) students who met the minimum level of satisfactory performance or higher on the STAAR EOC assessments.

Indicator #4 OSP Graduation Rate (PL Assignment)

Measures the percent of students ever in Foster Care, ever experiencing homelessness, or ever Military-Connected (OSP) students (nonduplicative count) who graduated with a high school diploma in four years.

Indicator #5 OSP Annual Dropout Rate (Grades 7-12) (PL Assignment)

Measures the percent of students in Foster Care, experiencing homelessness, or Military-Connected (OSP) students (nonduplicative count) in Grades 7-12 who dropped out in a given school year.

Indicator #6 OSP Dyslexia Representation (Ages 6-21) (Report Only - No PL Assigned)

Measures the difference in the rate of students in Foster Care, experiencing homelessness, or Military-Connected (OSP) students identified with dyslexia to the rate of all students identified with dyslexia in the LEA.
