Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Alex Remschel:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Shiner Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Shiner ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 1/31/2024 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Measurable Annual Goals
34 Code of Federal Regulations §300.320 (a)(2)(i)
- Transition: Postsecondary Goals
19 Texas Academic Code § 89.1055(h); Texas Education Code § 29.0111

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the abovementioned noncompliance. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that these areas of noncompliance have been addressed, and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on these issues is required at this time.
