



Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) Master's Degree Distance Venue Tuition Reimbursement Program



SLP Tuition Reimbursement Program

The SLP Tuition Reimbursement Program provides funding for students accepted into the SLP Master's Degree Distance Venue, Cycle 13, beginning in June 2025. The SLP Distance Venue is a partnership formed between the Texas Education Agency (TEA), Texas Education Service Centers (ESCs), Texas Woman's University (TWU), and local education agencies (LEAs) to address the shortage of licensed, certified SLPs in Texas public schools. A reimbursement scholarship is being offered through a partnership with TEA and Region 10 ESC to provide tuition reimbursement funding for qualifying expenses for the duration of the 27-month master's degree program. Upon completion of the program, participants must commit to provide a minimum of 3 years of service in a small and/or rural LEA in Texas.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for reimbursement, you must secure a sponsorship in:

- A "small" LEA with a K-12 population of 700 or less
OR
- A "rural" LEA, 60 or more miles from the nearest ESC
AND
- Be accepted into the TEA/ESC10 SLP Master's Degree Distance Venue, Cycle 13

Eligible Reimbursements

Program participants receive reimbursement for qualifying expenses for the length of the SLP Master's Degree Program beginning June 2025. TEA's Small and Rural Schools Network will administer the reimbursement funds for:

- Tuition & Fees
- Books
- CALIPSO fee
- "Residency Days" dorm+food+materials
- AVANT testing for Bilingual Certificate
