Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Dr. Jeanette Ball:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify Southwest Independent School District of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Monitoring.

Southwest ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated January 31, 2024, listing the following areas of noncompliance:

IEP Development: Present Levels of Academic and Functional Performance

- **34 Code of Federal Regulations §300.320(a)(1)**

IEP Development: Measurable Annual Goals

- **34 CFR §300.320(a)(2)(i)**

Transition: Post-secondary Goals

- **34 CFR §300.320(b)(1); Texas Administrative Code §89.1055(j)(1)**

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the abovementioned noncompliance. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that these areas of noncompliance have been addressed, and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on these issues is required at this time.
