## *Definitions

Regular Early Childhood Program is a program that includes a majority (at least 50 percent) of nondisabled children (i.e., children without IEPs). This category may include, but is not limited to:

- Head Start
- Kindergarten (public or private)
- Preschool (public or private)
- Group child development center or child care


## Separate Class

is a special education classroom that includes a majority (at least $50 \%$ ) of children with disabilities (i.e., children with IEPs). This category may include, but is not limited to:

- Regular school buildings
- Trailers/portables
- Child care facilities
- Hospital facilities (out-patient)
- Other community-based settings
