# Special Education Reporting Background





- IDEA Requirements: Annual federal reporting via SPP/APR
- State Performance Plan (SPP): Framework of indicators to measure performance and compliance
- Applicable Indicators:
  - SPPI 7 Preschool Outcomes
  - SPPI 11A/B Initial Evaluation & Eligibility Determination
  - SPPI 12 Early Childhood Transition
  - SPPI 13 Secondary Transition


## Data Collection – Current Methods (Historical)




#### **Separate Processes**

## Data Governance – How New Collections Are Approved






- Governance Process: Review for new data requests
- Authority to Collect Data: Federal / state requirement or law
- Approval Steps: (OP 10-07)

Needs Assessment → Stakeholder Input → Proposal → Green Light for Implementation

# Timeline – Transition to SPEDS Collection (2020–2025)





## Introducing the TSDS SPEDS Collection



- Unified Submission: TSDS SPEDS = One collection for SPPI 7, 11, 12, & 13
- Aligned Timeline: Single reporting period and one submission deadline
- Data Quality & Efficiency: TSDS validations; SIS/IEP data integration
- Mandatory for All LEAs: Submit data or certify zero-data



#### SPPI 11 – Child Find



#### **SPPI 11A – Timely Initial Evaluations**

45 school days – w/some specified exceptions (state timeline)

#### **SPPI 11B – Eligibility Determination**

30 calendar days after FIIE (federal and state requirement - 34 CFR §300.323(c)(1); TAC §89.1011(e))

- Compliance Indicator: 100%
- Child Find → SPEDS Submission
- No change in what data are submitted
- All LEAs complete the submission process

# SPPI 12 – Early Childhood Transition

Early Childhood
Transition

- Transition from Part C to Part B by age 3
- Compliance Indicator: 100%
- Child Find → SPEDS Submission
- No change to data submission
- All LEAs complete the submission process

# SPPI 7 – Preschool Outcomes (NEW in TSDS)





SPPI 7
Preschool
Outcomes

- Progress: Three Outcome Areas (Ages 3-5, not in kindergarten)
- COS Process: Ratings at Entry and Exit
- **Exit Reason:** at least 6 months & one of the exit criterion:
  - Dismissed by ARD Committee, or
  - Transitioned to Kindergarten, or
  - Child Turned Six Years Old
- Data Submission: Single submission (both Entry and Exit submitted upon Exit)
- Data Maintenance: Maintain COS ratings in student record

### SPPI 13 – Secondary Transition (NEW: Selection → Census)





**SPPI 13** 

Secondary Transition

- Ages 16 -21: IEPs contain secondary transition requirements
- **Compliance Indicator:** 100%
- Data Submission: TEAL to TSDS
- Data Elements: 8 IEP secondary transition requirements
- No More Selection: ALL applicable students report by system

## LEA Responsibilities for Data Submission




# **Special Education Program Staff & Data Steward/PEIMS**
