Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Mr. Justin Cowart:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Winona Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the **Cyclical Desk Review**.

Winona ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 1/31/2025 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Development of Present Levels of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance (PLAAFP)
34 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 300.320(a)(1)
- IEP Development: Development of measurable annual goals
34 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §300.320(a)(2)(i); 19 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §89.1055 (b)
- Transition: Initial transition held prior to the student's 14th birthday
19 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 89.1055(k)-(o); Texas Education Code (TEC) §29.0111

The corrective action plan addressed identified noncompliance. The local education agency (LEA) submitted documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) demonstrating the noncompliance has been corrected. Based on this evidence, the issue is considered resolved, and no further action is required at this time.
