

How to Guidance on Accessing TEHCY Grants on TEA's Grants Opportunities Page

This guide provides a step-by-step walkthrough for navigating the Texas Education Agency (TEA) Grant Opportunities website to locate active and/or past Texas Education of Homeless Children and Youth (TEHCY) Grants. This resource includes screenshots and detailed instructions to assist users in accessing grant information and completing the application process.

Step 1: Accessing the TEA Grant Opportunities Website

1. Open your web browser and go to the [TEA Grant Opportunities page](#).
2. This page serves as the central hub for all state and federal grants administered by TEA.

Step 2: Using the Search Options

1. Scroll to the “**Search Options**” section.
2. Under the “Keyword(s) in Application Name,” type in ‘homeless’.

3. All available grants will be listed in the “**Search Results – Available Grant Opportunities**” table.
 - a. Name of the Grant Application: The active school year for each grant is indicated in the name of the grant
 - b. Availability Date: Refers to the date when the application opens for applicants.
 - c. Due Date: The deadline for submitting the application.

- d. Application Type: Specifies the category or type of grant application.
- e. Submission Type: Indicates the method of submission, either via PDF or through the eGrants portal.

Step 3: View Grant Details

1. To view the details of any grant, click on the magnifying icon under 'View' next to each grant's name. For this guide, we will select **"2025-2026 Texas Education of Homeless Children and Youth (TEHCY)-Continuation"**.
2. Program Information: Provides essential details about the grant program to help applicants understand its scope and requirements.
 - a. Program Description: Summarizes the goals, objectives, and intended outcomes of the grant program.
 - b. Eligibility: Defines who can apply by outlining the specific criteria and qualifications required.
 - c. Statutory Authority: Identifies the legal basis and regulations that govern the grant program.

<p>Eligibility</p> <p>Eligible applicants include all School Systems and Education Service Centers (ESCs). LEAs are required to join a Shared Service Arrangement (SSA) if their projected grant amount is less than \$7,500.</p>
<p>Statutory Authority</p> <p>McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, Subtitle VII-B, reauthorized by Title IX, Part A,(ESSA) (42 U.S.C. 11431 et seq.)</p>

3. Funding Information: Explains the total funding available (amounts funded to each grantee will vary), allocation method, grant start and end date, and fund type (Federal or State.)

 - c. **Eligible Applicants Funding Amounts:** Specifies who can apply and the maximum or range of funding available to each applicant.
 - d. Additional resources may be listed that are specific to the respective grant being viewed.


SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION

This application must be submitted via email to grantapplications@tea.texas.gov by **11:59 p.m. CT, September 23, 2025.**

Both Application Part 1 (PDF) and Application Part 2 (Excel) are required when submitting.
The application may be signed with a digital ID, or it may be signed by hand and scanned. Then submit via email.

For eGrants

1. Log into the TEA eGrants system using your TEAL account. (If you do not already have access, you will need to request access in TEAL.)



2. Navigate to the GS2000 application for the TEHCY Continuation Grant.
3. Complete all required fields and upload supporting documents.
4. Submit the application electronically before the due date.
