

Publications Handbook of Texas




- The flagship publication of TSHA is the Handbook of Texas. First conceived by noted Texas historian Walter Prescott Webb while he served as TSHA president, the Handbook is a free-to-use encyclopedic resource regarding all things Texan.



Publications Texas Almanac




- The first edition of the *Texas* Almanac was issued by *The* Galveston News in 1857.


• The Southwestern Historical Quarterly is the oldest continually published scholarly journal in the United States.

Education Texas History Day April 23, 2022




- Each year thousands of Texas students create and present original research papers, exhibits, performances, websites, and documentaries of their own design.
