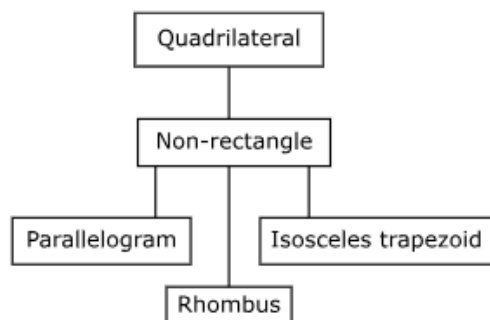

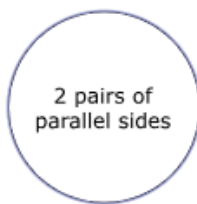

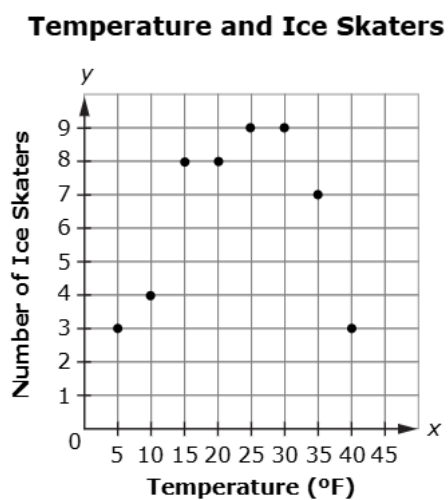
Graph three ordered pairs that follow the rule $y = x + 6$.

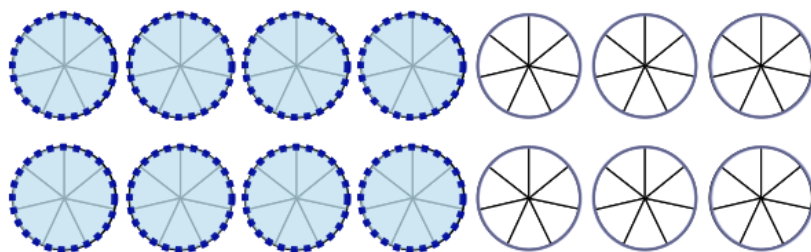

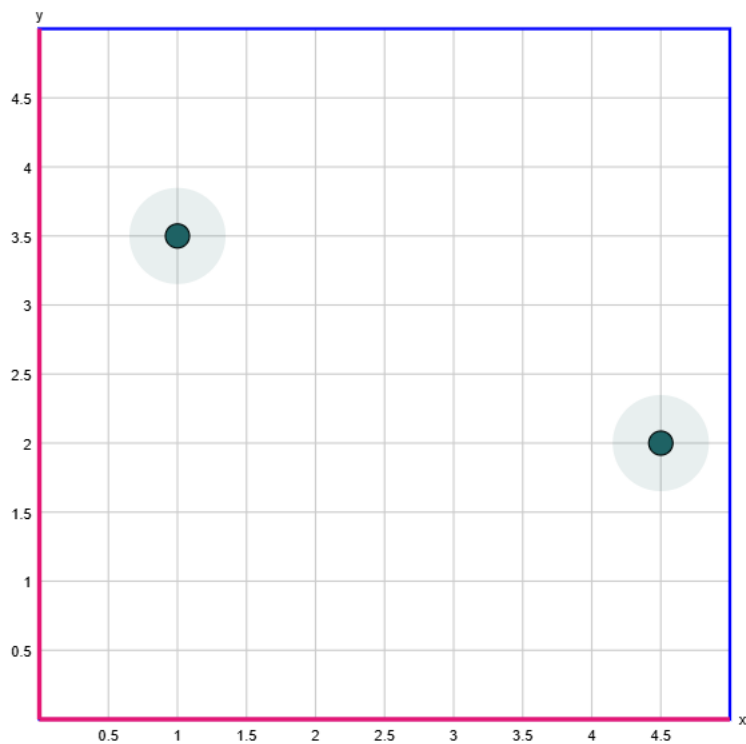
