



PREP Verification of Participation

The PREP Verification of Participation (VoP) exists to give schools systems that were awarded the PREP Allotment the opportunity to verify their official participation in the PREP Program Allotment. This step exists because a significant number of implementation details have been defined and shared with school systems since the application window. The VoP allows school systems to make informed decisions about how they choose to proceed with the PREP Program Allotment. The VoP includes two main components: participation decisions and information submission, including agreements to assurances with superintendent approval.

General Process

- The Primary Contact from the school system's LASO IV application will be emailed a link to the VoP form on May 1st, 2026
- Each school system must complete ONE VoP form
- The Superintendent or signature authority must sign the form where identified
- The form must be submitted by 11:59pm on May 31st, 2026

Participation Decisions

- The VoP form will allow school systems to select which of the PREP Program Allotments they want to implement from those that they were awarded
- There is no penalty nor negative ramifications for opting-out of any or all of the PREP Program Allotments awarded at this stage

Information Submission

- School Systems must submit in the VoP form:
 - Estimated participant counts for each PREP Program Allotment*
 - Agreement to statutorily-defined partnership agreement requirements (Residency and GYO)
 - Names of all confirmed EPP and/or IHE partners (Residency and GYO)
 - Uploads of written agreements with all EPP and/or IHE partners (Residency and GYO)
 - Agreement to all program-specific assurances

**TEA will not use estimated participant counts for calculating official allotments.*
