
Program Requirements Selected



2023-2024 Random Validation Items Alignment





Deadline to submit documentation via the FPC Random Validation WorkApp System.	October 23, 2023
TEA program staff complete preliminary reviews.	February 5, 2024
TEA contacts ESC regarding LEAs that receive "Improvement Needed" status for ESC review and comment before TEA notifies LEAs.	February 15, 2024 – March 1, 2024
FPC RV WorkApp LEA contacts receive notification of validation results. ESC FPC RV WorkApp Communication List Contacts will be copied.	March 18, 2024
ESC technical assistance deadline if LEA receives "Improvement Needed" status regarding any items.	September 30, 2024
ESC submits documentation in the FPC RV WorkApp System that technical assistance was offered/provided.	September 30, 2024
If the LEA receives "Improvement Needed" status on a program requirement, the LEA will be required to <u>submit</u> documentation for 2024-2025 for the same requirement. The documentation must be submitted in the FPC RV WorkApp System.	September 30, 2024





ESSA, Title IV, Part A, Section 4106(e)(1)(A-D)

- (e) Contents Of Local Application.—Each application submitted under this section by a local educational agency, or a consortium of such agencies, shall include the following:
 - (1) Descriptions.—A description of the activities and programming that the local educational agency, or consortium of such agencies, will carry out under this subpart, including a description of—
 - (A) any partnership with an institution of higher education, business, nonprofit organization, community-based organization, or other public or private entity with a demonstrated record of success in implementing activities under this subpart;
 - (B) if applicable, how funds will be used for activities related to supporting well-rounded education under section 4107;
 - (C) if applicable, how funds will be used for activities related to supporting safe and healthy students under section 4108;
 - (D) if applicable, how funds will be used for activities related to supporting the effective use of technology in schools under section 4109;

Documentation Required— Description of Title IV, Part A Programs and Activities*

Relevant pages of the most current LEA's District Improvement Plan (DIP) or other official auditable documentation providing a detailed description on how Title IV, Part A funds will be used for activities supporting <u>1</u> of the content areas (well-rounded education, safe and healthy students, or the effective use of technology).

^{*}Submit specific and relevant pages which support <u>only 1 content area</u>.



Description of Title IV, Part A Programs and Activities

Documentation Required – Description of Programs and Activities

Relevant pages of the most current LEA's District Improvement Plan (DIP) of activity(ies) <u>or</u> other official auditable documentation providing a **detailed description** on programs and activities funded to support the program objectives and intended outcomes related to 1 content area.





Issues that may result in an "Improvement Needed" status

- Auditable documentation requested was not submitted
- Documentation submitted does not provide a detailed description of the programs and activities supported in content area(s)
- Documentation submitted does not align to the requested Description of programs and activities item
- Documentation from a prior year was submitted instead of current year documentation
