Program Requirements Selected



Documenting overall compliance for a program requirement may require several forms of documentation to be maintained locally and available upon request by TEA and/or an auditor.



Program Requirements Selected



To ensure overall compliance with program requirements, LEAs should refer to the Program Guide and/or other program-related resources that reference the multiple forms of documentation required to be maintained locally.



Program Requirements Selected



The documentation requested for submission during the random validation process may not include all forms of documentation that are required to be maintained locally.



Meeting Documentation





Given the increased use of virtual meeting environments, participant rosters that include the meeting title, meeting date, and stakeholder names and roles would be acceptable substitutes for the more traditional sign-in sheets. This eliminates the need of a participant signature.

ESSA Statutory Requirement – Title I, Part A PNP Timely and Meaningful Consultation

Title I, Part A Programs. Consultation, ESSA Section 1117(b)(1)

- (b) Consultation
- (1) In General. To ensure timely and meaningful consultation, a local educational agency shall consult with appropriate private school officials during the design and development of such agency's programs under this part. Such agency and private school officials shall both have the goal of reaching agreement on how to provide equitable and effective programs for eligible private school children, the results of which agreement shall be transmitted to the ombudsman designated under subsection (a)(3)(B).



ESSA Statutory Requirement – Title VIII PNP Timely and Meaningful Consultation

Title VIII Programs (Titles IIA, IIIA, IVA, IVB). ESSA, Section 8501(c)(1)

- (c) Consultation
- (1) In General. To ensure timely and meaningful consultation, a State educational agency, local educational agency, educational service agency, consortium of those agencies, or entity shall consult with appropriate private school officials. Such agency and private school officials shall both have the goal of reaching agreement on how to provide equitable and effective programs for eligible private school children.



ESSA Consolidated Application – Timely and Meaningful Consultation Title I, Part A Program-Specific Provisions and Assurances

Assurances Relating to Title I, Part A Program, PNP Consultation

To ensure timely and meaningful consultation, the LEA shall consult with appropriate private school officials during the design and development of the LEA's Title I, Part A programs. The LEA and private school officials shall both have the goal of reaching agreement on how to provide equitable and effective programs for eligible private school children.

ESSA Consolidated Application – Timely and Meaningful Consultation Title VIII Program-Specific Provisions and Assurances

Assurances Relating to Title VIII Programs (Title I, Part C; Title II, Part A; Title III, Part A English Learner; Title III, Part A Immigrant; Title IV, Part A), PNP Consultation

The LEA will provide services to eligible children attending private elementary schools and secondary schools in accordance with Section 8501, and timely and meaningful consultation with private school officials regarding such services.

Issues that may result in an "Improvement Needed" status

- Auditable documentation requested was not submitted
- Documentation submitted does not reference the requested PNP validation requirement
- Documentation from a prior year was submitted instead of current year documentation
- Documentation does not provide two dated samples
