Program Requirements Selected



Documenting overall compliance for a program requirement may require several forms of documentation to be maintained locally and available upon request by TEA and/or an auditor.

Program Requirements Selected



To ensure overall compliance with program requirements, LEAs should refer to the Program Guide and/or other program-related resources that reference the multiple forms of documentation required to be maintained locally.

Program Requirements Selected



The documentation requested for submission during the random validation process may not include all forms of documentation that are required to be maintained locally.

Meeting Documentation Requested

Standard Documentation

- ✓ Meeting Agendas
- ✓ Meeting Notes/Minutes
- ✓ Sign-In Sheets

Meeting Documentation

Documentation for virtual meetings is acceptable.



Given the increased use of virtual meeting environments, participant rosters that include the meeting title, meeting date, and stakeholder names and roles would be acceptable substitutes for the more traditional sign-in sheets. This eliminates the need of a participant signature.

MEP Program Requirements Additional Guidance

The 2023-2024 Random Validation for the Title I, Part C program will only accept documentation for the current school year to ensure TEA is provided with adequate documentation to support the selected requirement.

2023-2024 Random Validation Process

Priority For Service (PFS)

Priority for Service (PFS)

The LEA gives service priority to migratory children who made a qualifying move within the previous 1-year period and who were failing or most at risk of failing to meet the challenging State academic standards [Sections 1301(2), 1304(d)].

Documentation Required

1.1 PFS Reports

Acceptable Documentation

- Copies of the monthly PFS Reports for the without student identifiable information
Reports showing “No students found” is acceptable.

Copies of the monthly PFS Reports without student identifiable information
Reports showing “No students found” is acceptable.

- Auditable documentation requested was not submitted.
- Documentation submitted does not reference the PFS Criteria.
- Documentation submitted was not for current school year.

Acceptable Documentation

- Copy of the district PFS Action Plan for the current school year

Documentation Required – Priority For Service (PFS) Item 1.2

Copy of the district PFS Action Plan for the current school year



Issues that may result in an “Improvement Needed” status

- Auditable documentation requested was not submitted.
- Documentation submitted does not reference the PFS Criteria.
- Documentation submitted does not include detailed activities.
- Documentation submitted was not for activities to take place in 2023-2024

1.3 Supplemental
Program Report
from TX-NGS

In addition, the following is required only for LEAs with PFS students:

Acceptable Documentation

Current year Supplemental Program Count Report from TX-NGS which lists supplemental services being provided to the PFS students. **Please redact student identifiable information and highlight the unique student number.**

Relevant documentation that shows MEP-services were provided to PFS students first.

- Auditable documentation requested was not submitted.
- Documentation is not for the current school year.
