

Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 Program Requirement Overview

Program Requirements Selected



Documenting overall compliance for a program requirement may require several forms of documentation to be maintained locally and available upon request by TEA and/or an auditor.

Program Requirements Selected



To ensure overall compliance with program requirements, LEAs should refer to the Program Guide and/or other program-related resources that reference the multiple forms of documentation required to be maintained locally.

Program Requirements Selected



The documentation requested for submission during the program monitoring process may not include all forms of documentation that are required to be maintained locally.

Program Evaluations

LEAs that conduct a program shall evaluate the program, disaggregating data on participation by gender, race, ethnicity and age not less than once every 3 years to determine program's impact.

Documentation Required

1.1 Documentation of evaluation of the Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 program showing impact in the areas referenced

Acceptable Documentation

1.1- Copy of the most current evaluation of the Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 Program.

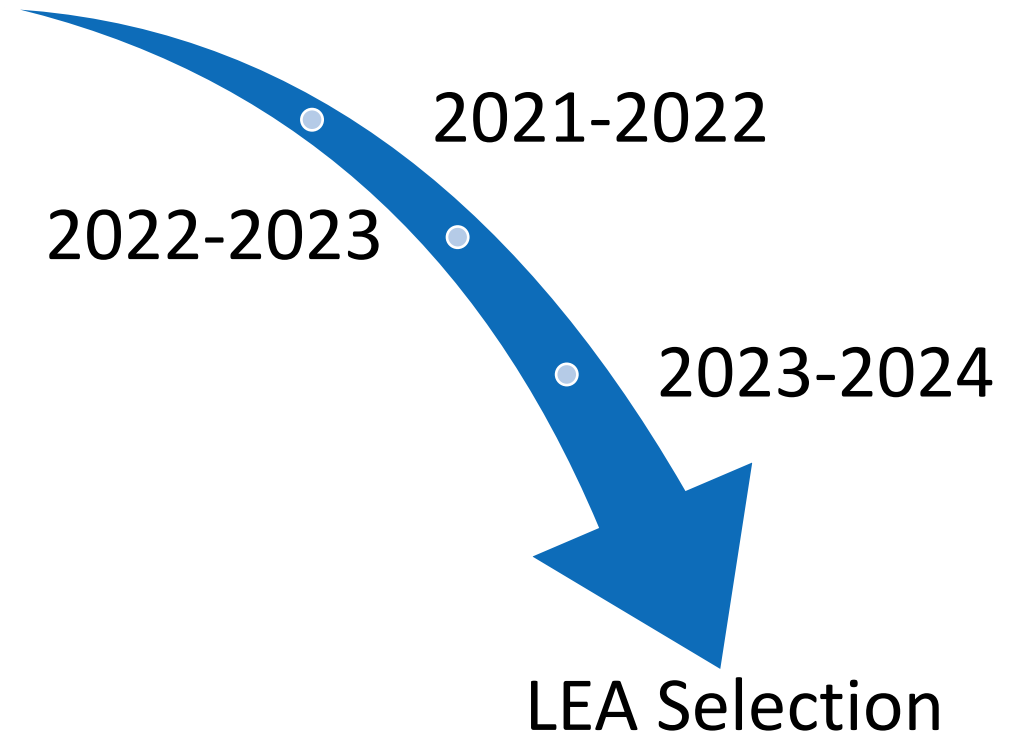
The evaluation should include an analysis of data showing the program's impact on each of the youth referenced below

- 1) youth that have maintained and improved educational achievement and graduated from high school,
- 2) youth that have accrued school credits that meet State requirements for grade promotion and high school graduation,
- 3) youth that have made the transition to regular program or other educational program operated by an LEA,
- 4) youth that have completed high school or its equivalent, and obtained employment after leaving the facility, and
- 5) youth that have participated in postsecondary education and/or job training programs.

Once every 3 years

- An evaluation may happen once every three years.
- That means that the evaluation can take place in any of the years listed to be within the range of the requirement as stated in statute.
- Documentation would need to be within the range of the years.
- If multiple evaluations exist, submit the most recent one.
