# Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 Program Requirement Overview



### **Program Requirements Selected**



Documenting overall compliance for a program requirement may require several forms of documentation to be maintained locally and available upon request by TEA and/or an auditor.



### **Program Requirements Selected**



To ensure overall compliance with program requirements, LEAs should refer to the Program Guide and/or other program-related resources that reference the multiple forms of documentation required to be maintained locally.



### **Program Requirements Selected**



The documentation requested for submission during the program monitoring process may not include all forms of documentation that are required to be maintained locally.



## Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 Program Requirement

### **Program Evaluations**

LEAs that conduct a program shall evaluate the program, disaggregating data on participation by gender, race, ethnicity and age not less than once every 3 years to determine program's impact.



# TEA Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 Program Requirement

### **Documentation** Required

1.1 Documentation of evaluation of the Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 program showing impact in the areas referenced

#### **Acceptable Documentation**

1.1- Copy of the most current evaluation of the Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 Program.


The evaluation should include an analysis of data showing the program's impact on each of the youth referenced below

- youth that have maintained and improved educational achievement and graduated from high school,
- youth that have accrued school credits that meet State requirements for grade promotion and high school graduation,
- youth that have made the transition to regular program or other educational program operated by an LEA,
- youth that have completed high school or its equivalent, and obtained employment after leaving the facility, and
- youth that have participated in postsecondary education and/or job training programs.



### **TEA** Once every 3 years

- An evaluation may happen once every three years.
- That means that the evaluation can take place in any of the years listed to be withing the range of the requirement as stated in statute.
- Documentation would need to be within the range of the years.
- If multiple evaluations exist, submit the most recent one.
