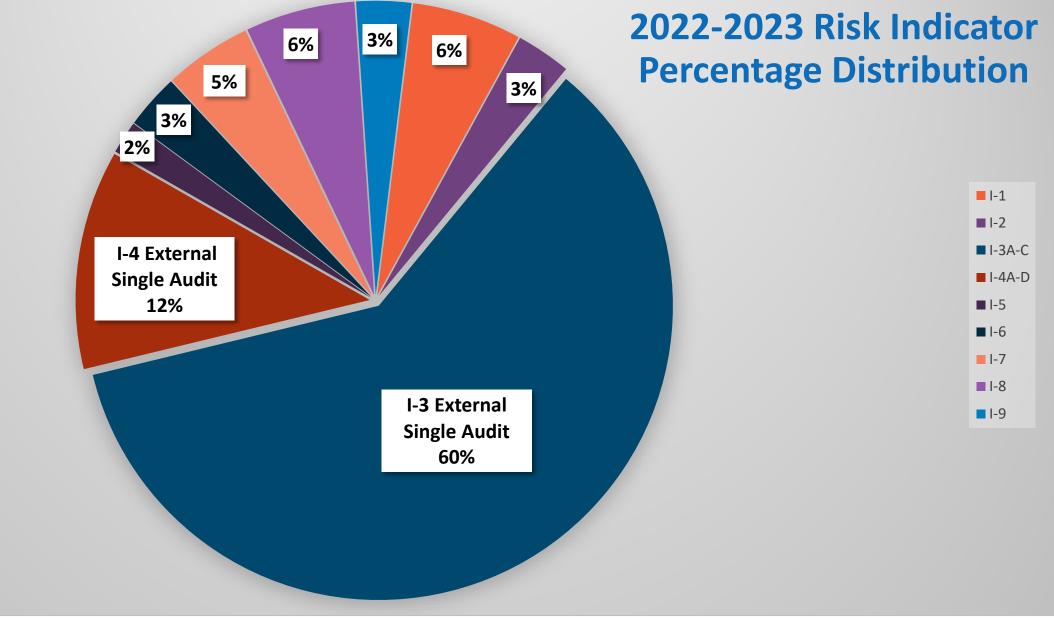

New Direction: The Federal Compliance Officer housed in the Department of Grant Compliance and Administration now manages GCA Risk Assessment activities, data, and training.



<u>Continuous Improvement:</u> Provide opportunities for LEAs and ESCs to provide input and feedback to GCA staff at conferences, ESC, and TEA trainings.



<u>Support:</u> Increase technical assistance, training, and resources available to LEAs and ESCs with a high-risk or medium-risk grantee designation or have multiple non-compliance referrals.

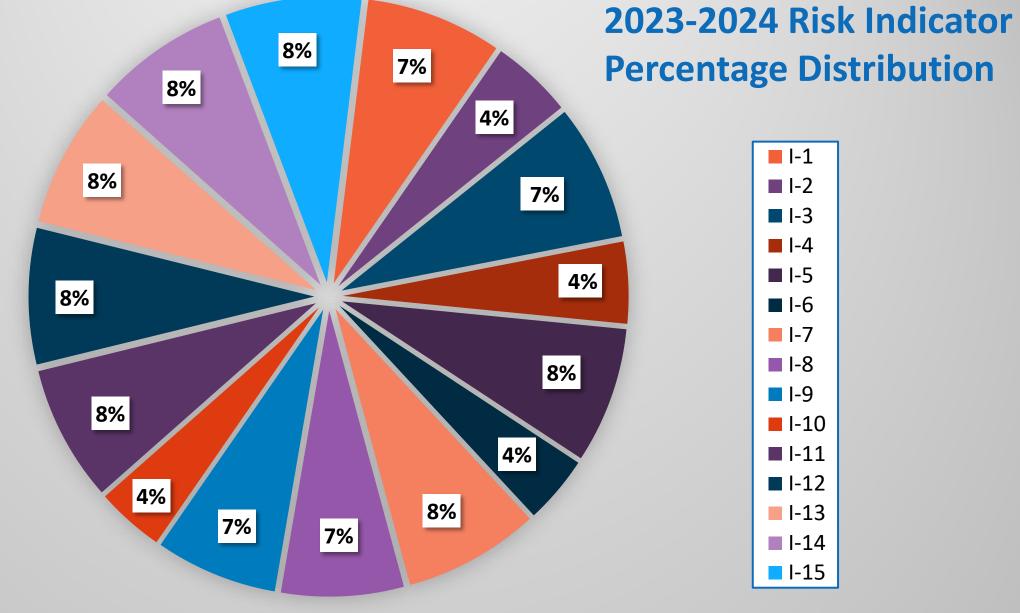

2023-2024 Risk Indicator Point Distribution







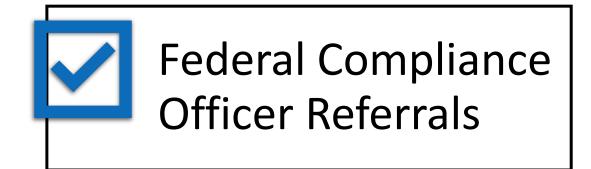
Expansion of Risk Assessment Indicators for 2024-2025

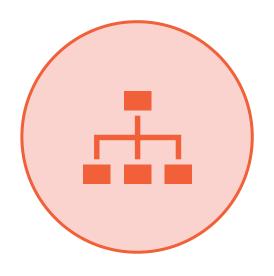


Post Award Compliance (PAC)

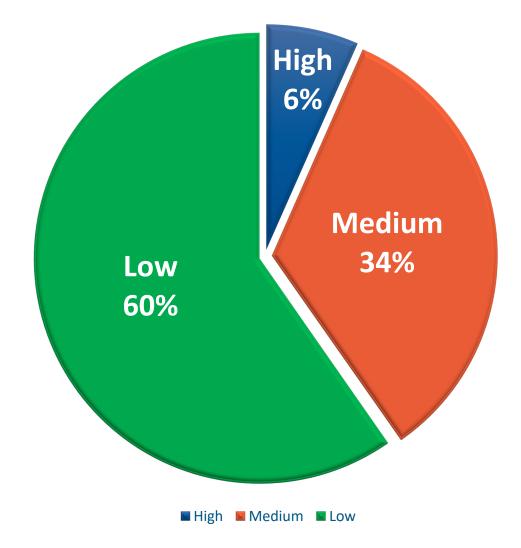

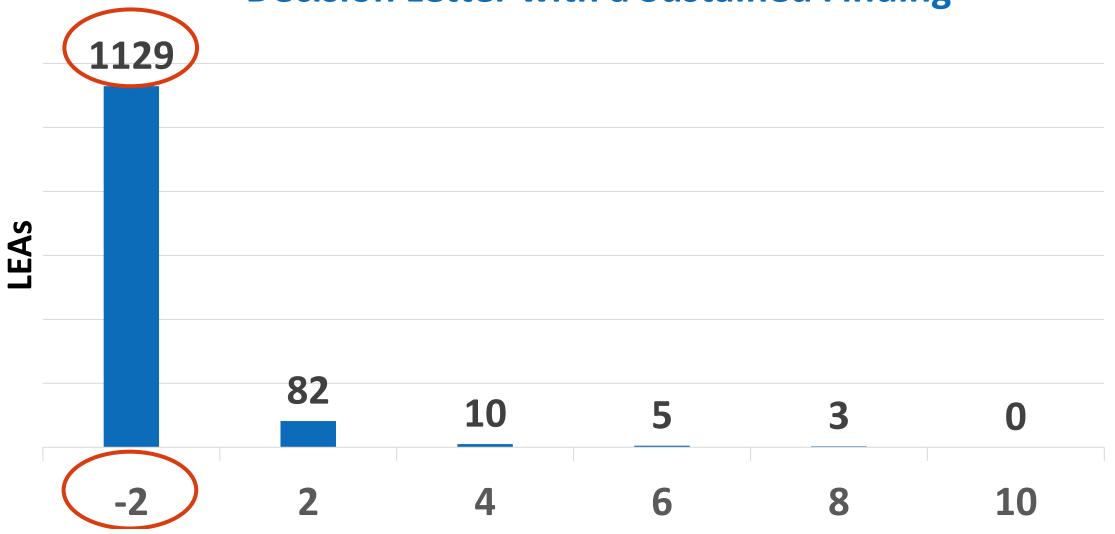

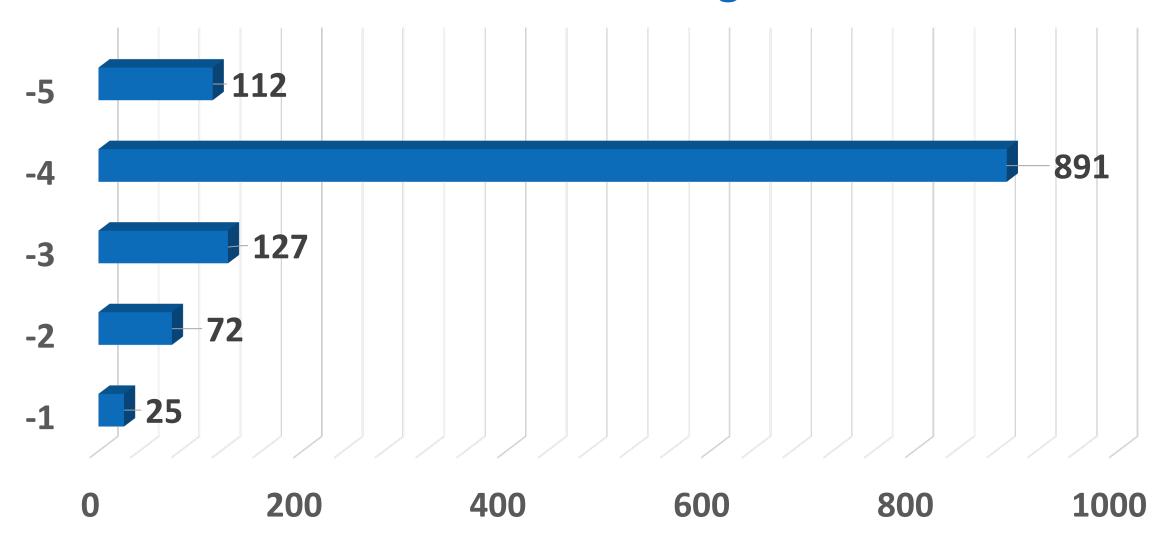




Risk Points Awarded: I-11 FFM and SMD LEA Audit Percentage of Disallowed Costs Compared to Grant Award

Risk Assessment





The Texas Education Agency, as a pass-through entity, awards federal grant funds to eligible sub-recipients, including local educational agencies (LEAs), which include both school districts and open-enrollment charter schools, education service centers (ESCs), and non-profits. TEA as a pass-through entity is required under Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), 2 CFR §200.332(b), to evaluate each sub-recipient risk of non-compliance with Federal statutes, regulations, and the terms and conditions of the sub-award for purposes of determining the appropriate sub-recipient monitoring as described in 2 CFR §200.332(d)(e), which may include the sub-recipients results of previous audits, including Single-Audits in accordance with 2 CFR §200.332(f), changes to key personnel, and other factors that may reflect any patterns of non-compliance.

The Federal Compliance Officer in the Department of Grant and Administration (GCA) manages all GCA Risk Assessment activities, data, technical assistance, and training.

To comply with this requirement, the Federal Compliance Officer conducts an annual risk assessment of all subrecipients to determine and mitigate any potential risk of non-compliance. Based on the outcome of the annual risk assessment, sub-recipients are assigned a risk status of low, medium, or high, which is evaluated annually.

- 3. Select LEA Name and CDN when the 2023-2024 GCA Risk Assessment page displays.
- 4. Click on the Attachments link and click on the LEA RA Report.pdf title.
- 5. The report will download to your computer's download folder.
- 6. Click on the downloaded report to view your 2023-2024 LEA Risk Assessment Status Designation Report.
- 7. Each LEA report includes points assigned by indicator, total risk assessment score, and risk status designation for 2023-2024.

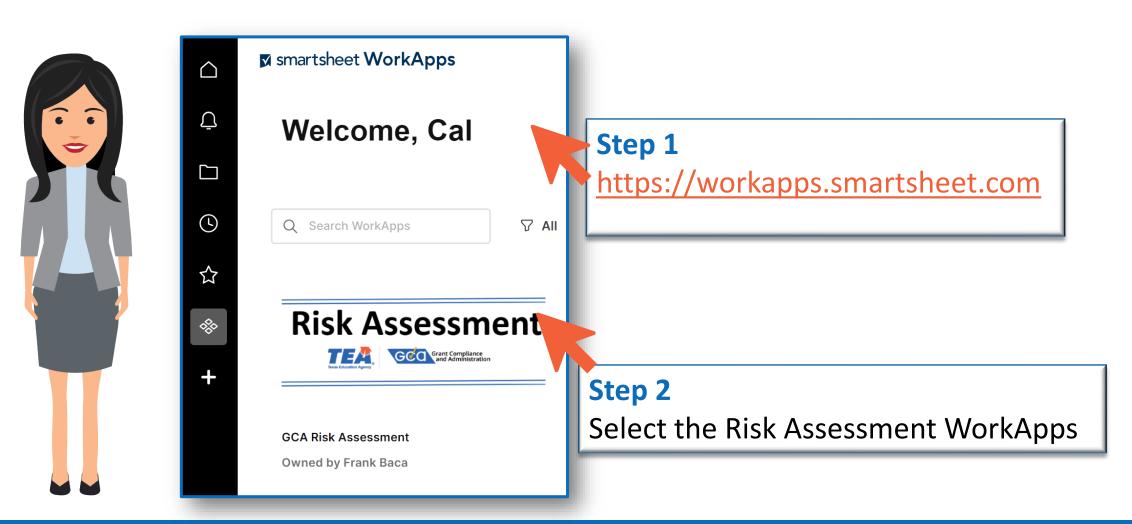

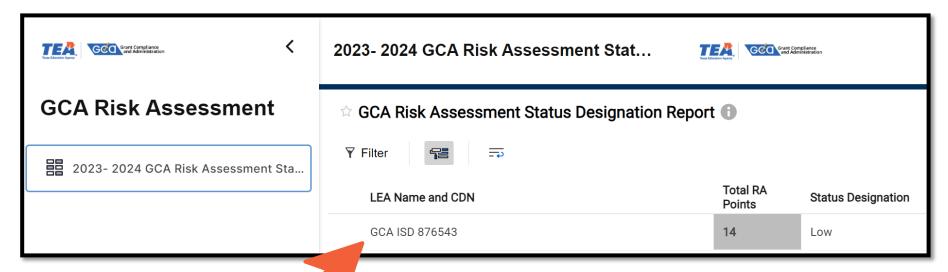
2023-2024 Risk Assessment WorkApps





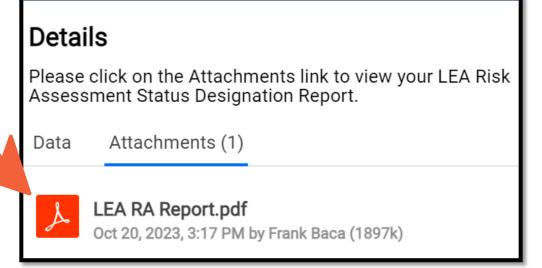


GCA ISD Risk Assessment Status Designation Report
