A. Summary of Program

The Career and Technical Education (CTE) program at Chapel Hill High school currently offers a four-sequence course option for the Education and Training program of study. All students have the opportunity to participate in the newly implemented "Academies of Chapel Hill." Students explore all career programs at the Freshman level and then move into advanced career courses their sophomore through senior year. The Education and Training pipeline consists of Child Development, Instructional Practices, and a Practicum in Education course during the students' senior year. In order to recruit and retain highly qualified teachers and grow current staff, the district has implemented a program to allow graduating seniors and current paraprofessionals an opportunity to earn an alternative certification while still employed in the school district. The goals for the students in the Education Training program are as follows: 1) Provide students with high quality work based learning experiences with a variety of grade levels; 2) Prepare students for postsecondary education through rigorous dual credit courses; and 3) retain highly qualified instructors and site teachers for student learning. Students in the Education Training Program also participate and compete in the Texas Association of Future Educators (TAFE). Students use the ideas and skills learned in their site based program to create projects and lessons to compete on a state and national level.

B. Qualifications and Experience for Key Personnel

Existing position: The existing Education and Training teacher is responsible for implementing the curriculum, dual credit through our local junior college, and overseeing the site-based student placements. The teacher currently holds a standard teacher certificate and a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership. Additionally, the teacher has been credentialed through our local junior college, Tyler Junior College, and taught dual credit courses for the 2023-2024 school year. The grant manager is the Associate Principal at Chapel Hill High School who supervises and evaluates all career and technical education programs. The grant manager is also responsible for classroom observations to ensure the appropriate curriculum is implemented. Site teachers are located on the elementary, intermediate, and junior high sites and may vary from year to year. The primary responsibility of the site teacher is to serve as a mentor to high school students by providing them with a "student teacher" experience. The college and career counselors meet with students each year to discuss all career pathways and inform them of course requirements.

Chapel Hill ISD seeks to retain highly qualified professionals through competitive salaries, continuous professional development, and a program for future educators to receive their standard teaching certificate through a district program. The goal is to recruit certified teachers who have completed the rigorous coursework needed to facilitate the curriculum in the Education and Training Program. The district promotes the position through social media, school websites, and job fairs.

The goals/activities of the Education and Training Program are as follows:

- 1.) Provide all high school students enrolled in the Education and Training Program with an internship experience with a certified classroom teacher. Activities: Students are assigned to a campus each year where they shadow the classroom teacher, work with students in small groups, and create/implement lessons.
- 2.) Provide site teachers with the appropriate professional development to assist with work-based experiences. Activities: At the beginning of each year, the Education and Training instructor hosts training sessions for partner schools.
- 3) Provide evaluations for student work-based experiences and continuous monitoring of the program. Activities: Site teachers are required to complete evaluations every six weeks. The Education and Training instructor also conducts weekly walkthroughs and evaluations at assigned campuses. Data is evaluated at the end of the semester by the teachers.

D. Performance and Evaluation Measures

Students are placed with site teachers throughout the district in Instructional Practices and Practicum courses. The Education and Training teacher supervises these visits and six-week evaluations are completed by the site teacher. In addition to evaluations, the Education and Training teacher provides the site teacher with training plans and surveys to ensure that the work-based learning experience meets the required criteria and properly prepares students for the transition into the classroom. Dual credit courses are offered for Instructional Practices and the Practicum in Education course.. Students take one course in their junior and senior years. These courses align with the current course standards and allow the teacher to gauge the effectiveness of the program.

The proposed budget will provide a stipend for the existing Education and Training teacher for \$11,000. This will be dispersed over the two-year grant timeline in the Spring semester. This stipend will be used for the current Education and Training teacher for the 2023-2024 school year who teaches Instructional Practices and Practicum in Education.

The Education and Training teacher is the existing teacher from the 2023-2024 school year. At the beginning of each school year, the Education and Training teacher hosts an informational meeting for all elementary, intermediate, and junior high teachers interested in supervising a student teacher. Site teachers are trained and given requirements for the school year. Teachers for all departments are offered the opportunity to participate in the work-based learning experiences. All grade levels, special education, and fine arts are encouraged to participate and work with high school students. In addition to coursework, students are evaluated for their on-site experience every six weeks by their site teacher. The Education and Training teacher also conducts random site visits and utilizes her observations to rate students. Teachers also utilize high school students during selected campus events before and after school and this is due to the relationships that site teachers have created with students during field experiences.


