SISD's strategy to garner job application and interviewing skills will be met by creating an application that will allow students with the real world experience of applying for a job. From the applications submitted by students we will conduct interviews, which will require students to practice job interview skills and learn proper interview etiquette such as appropriate attire, speaking skills, eye contact and asking follow up questions.
