

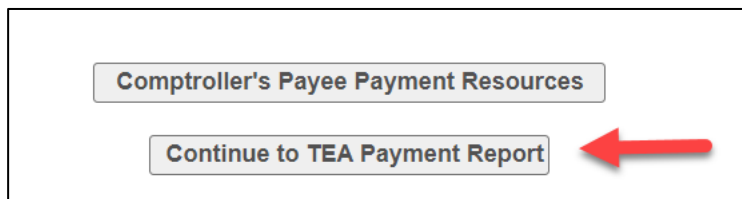


## Viewing IDEA-B Discretionary Residential Reimbursement Payments

Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, Part B (IDEA-B) Discretionary Residential reimbursement payments will be direct deposited into the local educational agency's (LEA's) bank account. *If you are a member of a special education shared services arrangement (SSA), the payment will go to your SSA Fiscal Agent on your behalf.*

You can check the status of your LEA's payment in the TEA Payment Report system.

1. Navigate to the [TEA Payment Report](#) system.
2. At the bottom of the 'TEA Payment Report Instructions' page, click **Continue to TEA Payment Report**.



3. Enter your LEA's **County District Number**. Select the current **Fiscal Year**. Enter **FAR FUND Code 226 (or 315)** if you are the Fiscal Agent of a special education shared services arrangement [SSA]). Then click **Show Payments**.

4. All payments to the LEA in the selected search parameters will appear. This payment will be titled **IDEA-B DISCR. RESIDENTIAL**. The NOGA ID/Project ID, Payment Amount, and Payment Date will also be displayed.
