HB 1416

HB 1416 Overview

Texas law mandates that students who do not achieve “Approaches” or higher on the STAAR or End of Course administrations must receive accelerated instruction. This can be provided in two ways:

- 1. TIA-designated teacher:** Instruction provided by a teacher designated under the Teacher Incentive Allotment (TIA)
- 2. Supplemental Instruction:**
 - **15 hours:** For students who score in the “High Does Not Meet” category.
 - **30 hours:** For students who score in the “Low Does Not Meet” category, have a consecutive school year failure, or fail grade 3 math and/or reading.



HB 1416 Ratio Waiver List

HB 1416 Ratio Waiver List

- (a-11) The agency shall approve one or more products that use an automated, computerized, or other augmented method for providing supplemental instruction under Subsection (a-1)(2) that may be used in lieu of some or all of the individual or group instruction required under Subsection (a-4)(6), as appropriate for the applicable grade level and subject area and a student's academic deficiency. The agency may approve a product under this subsection only if evidence indicates that the product is more effective than the individual or group instruction required under Subsection (a-4)(6). The commissioner shall adopt rules regarding when a product approved under this subsection may be used and the requirements under Subsection (a-4) for which the product may be substituted.

Note: LEAs may use any curricular tool that meets HB 1416 requirements to support accelerated instruction. However, only products approved through the HB 1416 RWL qualify for a waiver of the 4:1 student-to-tutor ratio.

HB 1416 Ratio Waiver List Products

- **Eligible Products:** Products that use automated, computerized, or other augmented methods for providing accelerated instruction.
- **Instruction Mode:** Approved products **do not require live in-person or online educators** to deliver the primary mode of instruction
- **Ratio Waiver:** Products approved through the HB 1416 Ratio Waiver List qualify for a waiver of the 4-to-1 student-to-tutor ratio.

- **Part 1 – Texas Education Agency**
 - **Prerequisites:** Webinar attendance and review of the Vendor Application Guide
 - **Product alignment:** Product alignment with statutory and strategic focus areas
 - **TEKS alignment:** Alignment with TEKS per the applicable subject and grade level
 - **Emergent bilingual resources:** Availability of resources for emergent bilingual students
 - **Effectiveness Evidence:** Verification of evidence indicating that the product is more effective than individual or group instruction

- **Part 2- Third Party Review (Texas Tech University)**
 - **Progress monitoring:** Tools and reports for monitoring student progress
 - **Student Independence:** Effective tools that support student independence
 - **Usage Metrics:** Recommended research-based usage metrics for HB 1416 RWL products
 - **Research Studies:** Rigorous research studies evaluating the efficacy of HB 1416 RWL product
 - **Effectiveness Evidence:** Evaluation of evidence indicating that product is more effective than individual or group instruction

HB 1416 Ratio Waiver List Renewal Requirements



RWL vendors must provide an annual STAAR outcomes analysis evaluating the impact of product usage on student STAAR outcomes.



Supplemental math products must be approved through the State Board of Education Instructional Materials Review and Approval to remain on the Ratio Waiver List beyond the 2025-26 school year.



Supplemental reading products must undergo the IMRA process when it becomes available (expected fall 2026) to maintain Ratio Waiver List approval in subsequent years.



Ratio Waiver List Product Implementation and Best Practices

How to Use Products on the Ratio Waiver List

- **Notify Parents or Guardians:** Inform parents or guardians that a product on the Ratio Waiver List will be used to provide the required accelerated instruction.
- **Meet Usage Requirements:** Ensure that applicable students meet the minimum product usage requirements for the approved product to benefit from the waived ratio requirement.
- **Complete Hours:** Ensure that the required hours of supplemental instruction are completed before the subsequent State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR®) administration in the spring.
- **Contracting and Funding:** Assume responsibility for contracting and funding the selected vendors included from the TEA list of approved vendors.



Ratio Waiver List Best Practices

The tools approved on this list, when implemented effectively with quality educator training and sufficient time in a master schedule, can reduce educator workload while addressing individual learning gaps in full group or high-impact tutoring settings. However, these tools are not a substitute for excellent teaching.

- Incorporate as part of extended block or intervention period
- Alignment with classroom instruction
- Rule language states that school systems may “use a product on the Ratio Waiver List remotely, regardless of primary mode of instruction (i.e., in-person, virtual, or hybrid) only if the school district ensures that time spent by the student engaged in the product is aligned with approved product usage expectations documented by the school district”
