The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Hallsville Independent School District of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Hallsville ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 4/30/2025 listing the following area of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Development of measurable annual goals
34 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §300.320(a)(2)(i); 19 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §89.1055(b)

The corrective action plan addressed identified noncompliance. The local education agency (LEA) submitted documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) demonstrating the noncompliance has been corrected. Based on this evidence, the issue is considered resolved, and no further action is required at this time.
