

Texas Performance Reporting System (TPRS) User Guide (2026-2027)

Overview of TPRS

The Texas Performance Reporting System (TPRS) is a public Texas Education Agency (TEA) reporting platform that provides detailed district, campus, region, and statewide performance information. TPRS contains data related to student achievement, school progress, attendance, graduation, postsecondary readiness, student demographics, staff information, and other educational indicators.

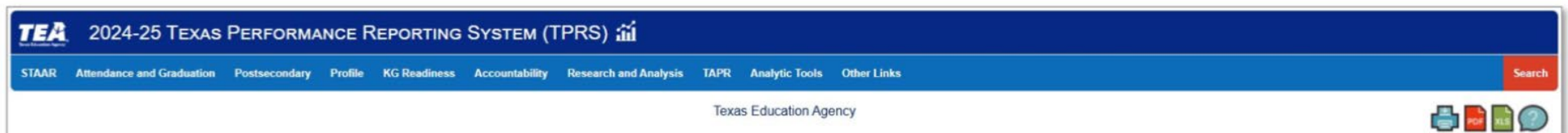

Key TPRS Definitions and Data Considerations

Understanding the concepts below can help interpret TPRS data accurately. For complete definitions, methodologies, and calculation information, refer to the [TPRS Glossary](#).

Accountability Subset vs. All Students: Some reports display results for the Accountability Subset, while others display results for All Students. Accountability Subset students are enrolled on both the PEIMS Fall Snapshot date and the assessment date. Because the student populations differ, reported results may vary between reports. For information on accountability subset rules, see [Chapter 1 of the Accountability Rating System Manual](#).

Enrollment vs. Membership: Represents students reported as enrolled on the Fall PEIMS Snapshot date. Membership excludes students served for fewer than two hours per day and may differ from enrollment counts.

Approaches, Meets, and Masters Grade Level: STAAR performance reports include results for Approaches Grade Level or Above, Meets Grade Level or Above, and Masters Grade Level. These performance levels provide different perspectives on student achievement.

Annual vs. Longitudinal Rates: Annual rates reflect outcomes within a single school year, while longitudinal rates follow a cohort of students over multiple years. Graduation reports commonly include 4-year, 5-year, and 6-year extended longitudinal measures.

College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR): Annual graduates demonstrate college, career, or military readiness by meeting one or more approved CCMR indicators reported within TPRS.

Masking: Some data may be suppressed or masked to protect student confidentiality and comply with federal privacy requirements. As a result, certain values may not be displayed in reports.

Report Year: Different measures may be based on different reporting years or data collections. Review the school year associated with a report before making comparisons.

Differences Across Reports: Differences in student populations, calculation methodologies, reporting years, accountability rules, or reporting requirements may cause results to vary across reports.
