Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Mr. Richard Kilgore :

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Bruceville-Eddy Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Bruceville-Eddy ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 2/28/2022 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- IEP Development:
34 CFR § 300.320(a)(1) - Development of Present Levels of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance (PLAAFP)
34 CFR § 300.320(a)(2)(i) - Development of Measurable Annual Goals

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the issue of noncompliance noted above. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that this area of noncompliance has been addressed and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on this issue is required at this time.
