Statutory Citations Relating to New 19 TAC Chapter 97, <u>Planning and Accountability</u>, Subchapter EE, <u>Accreditation Status</u>, <u>Standards</u>, and <u>Sanctions</u>, Division 1, <u>Status</u>, <u>Standards</u>, and <u>Sanctions</u>, §97.1070, <u>Increasing Intensity of Interventions and Sanctions</u>

Texas Education Code (TEC), §39A.901, Annual Review:

- (a) The commissioner shall annually review the performance of a school district or campus subject to this chapter to determine the appropriate actions to be implemented under this chapter.
- (b) The commissioner must review at least annually the performance of a school district for which the accreditation status or performance rating has been lowered due to insufficient student performance and may not raise the accreditation status or performance rating until the district has demonstrated improved student performance.
- (c) If the review conducted under this section reveals a lack of improvement, the commissioner shall increase the level of state intervention and sanction unless the commissioner finds good cause for maintaining the current status.

TEC, §39A.251, Applicability of Interventions and Sanctions to Open-Enrollment Charter School:

Interventions and sanctions authorized under this chapter for a school district or campus apply in the same manner to an open-enrollment charter school.

TEC, §39A.252, Rules:

- (a) The commissioner shall adopt rules to implement procedures to impose intervention or sanction provisions under this chapter as those provisions relate to an open-enrollment charter school.
- (b) In adopting rules under this section, the commissioner shall require that the charter of an openenrollment charter school be automatically:
 - (1) revoked if the charter school is ordered closed under this chapter; or
 - (2) modified to remove authorization for an individual campus if the campus is ordered closed under this chapter.
