Reporting Student Data File Format

Overview

Following is a list of the most significant changes being implemented in the 2020 TELPAS Reporting Student Data File Format.

- Added TSDS PEIMS DYSLEXIA-INDICATOR-CODE. See Position 180.
- Added Item Analysis for Reading Released Test items. The correct responses have been added to the data file (positions 771–810) and the student responses (positions 811–850) will reflect the student's response to the items as opposed to whether or not the student got the item correct (value of 1) or incorrect (value of 0).
- Added 2019 TELPAS History Information. See Positions 1040-1072.

NOTE: The data will be provided in a fixed-length text file format with the layout defined below. The file extension will be .txt. Tab-delimited files are not available.

Advanced High requires a composite score of 3.5 or higher, and a minimum proficiency level of advanced in all domains. Advanced requires a composite score of 2.5 or higher, a minimum proficiency level of intermediate in all domains, and a minimum proficiency level of advanced in at least half of the domains in which the student was assessed. Intermediate requires a composite score of 1.5 or higher, and a minimum proficiency level of intermediate in at least half of the domains in which the student was assessed. A Beginning ratings is given to a student whose composite score fails to meet the Intermediate requirements.
