Documenting overall compliance for a program requirement may require several forms of documentation to be maintained locally and available upon request by TEA and/or an auditor.

### **Program Requirements Selected**




The documentation requested for submission during the random validation process may not include all forms of documentation that are required to be maintained locally.



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# ESSA Statutory Requirement – Title I, Part A PNP Timely and Meaningful Consultation

#### Title I, Part A Programs. Consultation, ESSA Section 1117(b)(1)

- (b) Consultation
- (1) In General. To ensure timely and meaningful consultation, a local educational agency shall consult with appropriate private school officials during the design and development of such agency's programs under this part. Such agency and private school officials shall both have the goal of reaching agreement on how to provide equitable and effective programs for eligible private school children, the results of which agreement shall be transmitted to the ombudsman designated under subsection (a)(3)(B).



# ESSA Statutory Requirement – Title VIII PNP Timely and Meaningful Consultation

#### Title VIII Programs (Titles IIA, IIIA, IVA, IVB). ESSA, Section 8501(c)(1)

- (c) Consultation
- (1) In General. To ensure timely and meaningful consultation, a State educational agency, local educational agency, educational service agency, consortium of those agencies, or entity shall consult with appropriate private school officials. Such agency and private school officials shall both have the goal of reaching agreement on how to provide equitable and effective programs for eligible private school children.



#### ESSA Consolidated Application – Timely and Meaningful Consultation Title I, Part A Program-Specific Provisions and Assurances

#### Assurances Relating to Title I, Part A Program, PNP Consultation

To ensure timely and meaningful consultation, the LEA shall consult with appropriate private school officials during the design and development of the LEA's Title I, Part A programs. The LEA and private school officials shall both have the goal of reaching agreement on how to provide equitable and effective programs for eligible private school children.

# Assurances Relating to Title VIII Programs (Titles II, Part A; Title III, Part A English Learner; Title III, Part A Immigrant; Title IV, Part A), PNP Consultation

The LEA will provide services to eligible children attending private elementary schools and secondary schools in accordance with Section 8501, and timely and meaningful consultation with private school officials regarding such services.

# LEA Compliance Report: PNP Compliance Self-Check – Timely and Meaningful *Consultation*

#### Issues that may result in an "Improvement Needed" status

- Auditable documentation requested was not submitted
- Documentation submitted does not reference the requested PNP validation requirement
- Documentation from a prior year was submitted instead of current year documentation

ESC staff will contact LEA to:	Contact within 3 business days after notification to LEA. Technical assistance through January 13, 2022
Deadline to upload documentation on ESSA Reports.	January 14, 2022
TEA program staff complete preliminary reviews.	March 11, 2022
TEA contacts ESC regarding LEAs that receive "Improvement Needed" status for ESC review and comment before TEA notifies LEAs.	March 12–April 8, 2022
Notification to LEA administrator of validation results for. ESCs will be copied.	April 26, 2022
ESC technical assistance deadline if LEA receives "Improvement Needed" status regarding any items.	September 29, 2022
ESC provides documentation on ESSA Reports that technical assistance was offered/provided.	September 29, 2022
If the LEA receives "Improvement Needed" status on a program requirement, the LEA will be required to <u>submit documentation</u> for 2022-2023 for the same requirement. The documentation must be uploaded on ESSA Reports.	September 30, 2022
