AMENDMENT TO STANDARD CONTRACT BETWEEN TEXAS EDUCATION AGENCY AND

It is mutually understood and agreed by and between the undersigned contracting parties of the above numbered Contract to amend said Contract effective August 31, 2016 as follows:

ARTICLE II. PERIOD OF CONTRACT

TEA is exercising option to renew the Parliamentarian Contract from September 1, 2016 to August 31, 2017, final renewal, as allowed in the Contract term.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE OF CONTRACT

The Contractor will continue to provide Parliamentarian services for the State Board of Education (SBOE) meetings to include but not limited:

- a) Assist in conducting open meetings/hearings in accordance with standard rules of order
- b) Assist interpreting written rules of parliamentary procedure formally adopted by the SBOE
- c) Assist the Chairman in following such rules relating to the orderly transaction of business in meetings and to the duties of officers in that connection
- d) Assist the Chairman in facilitating the meeting of the SBOE members and the public attending the meeting
- e) Assist the Chairman in providing a firm basis for resolving questions of procedure that may arise
- f) Assist the Chairman in facilitating the decision-making process at the SBOE meetings
- g) Assist the Chairman in ensuring that discussion is clear, and that the rights of both the majority and the minority are protected
- h) Assist the Chairman in suspending the rules at the committee level to develop a consensus decision-making process
- i) Provide advice on Rules of Order to the Chairman or other board members via telephone or in person between formal meetings of the SBOE

A former state officer or employee of a state agency who during the period of state service or employment participated on behalf of a state agency in a procurement or contract negotiation involving a person may not accept employment from that person before the second anniversary of the date the officer's or employee's service or employment with the state agency ceased.

Effective January 1, 2016, the mileage reimbursement rate is .54¢. Receipts must be made available for programmatic or financial audit, by TEA and by others authorized by law or regulation to make such an audit, for a period of not less than seven (7) years.
