It is mutually understood and agreed by and between the undersigned contracting agencies of the above referenced contract to amend said contract effective September 1, 2015 as follows:

TEA is exercising the option to renew the Contract from September 1, 2015 to August 31, 2016.

Revised Description of Services and Revised Budget documents attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Contract Amount: \$ 68,842.00
 Amendment Amount: \$ 35,000.00
 New Contract Amount \$ 103,842.00

Pursuant to Section 2252.901 of the Texas Government Code, Contractor certifies that it is not a former employee of TEA or that Contractor has not been an employee of TEA for twelve (12) months prior to the beginning date of this contract.

Contractor must make full disclosure of intent to employ or subcontract with an individual who is a former employee/retiree of TEA. Within the first twelve months of leaving employment at TEA, a former employee/retiree selected by the Contractor for employment or subcontracting, shall not perform services on a project or fill a position that the former employee/retiree worked on while employed at TEA.

Revisions to the Contract General Provisions are indicated below:

Texas Government Code § 572.069. CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT FOR FORMER STATE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE RESTRICTED. A former state officer or employee of a state agency who during the period of state service or employment participated on behalf of a state agency in a procurement or contract negotiation involving a person may not accept employment from that person before the second anniversary (24 months) of the date the officer's or employee's service or employment with the state agency ceased.

All other terms and conditions of the original contract remain the same and are incorporated herein as if specifically written. It is agreed and accepted by the authorized representatives of the undersigned parties that all terms and conditions of this amendment are effective on the date written above.



**TSTEM and ECHS Online Designation Application Maintenance Contract
 IAC #3086, University of Texas at Austin
 Revised Description of Services
 September 1, 2015 – August 31, 2016**

I. Purpose and Objectives:

TRC will provide server hosting for the TSTEM and ECHS Designation online applications and technical support for TEA staff, reviewers, and applicants.

II. Objectives/Tasks:

Maintain an online application portal for all Texas schools seeking TSTEM and ECHS designation.

Expectations:

1. Applications that were developed in 2013-14 will be hosted on the TRC server.
2. Applications will be accessible through standard web browsers without need for unique software installation. Applications will be accessible 24/7.
3. Solution will allow TEA staff or external reviewers to review and score all applications online through standard web browsers.
4. TRC will provide technical support to all applicants, reviewers and TEA staff in accessing the online application, completing reviews, etc.
 - a. Technical support will be provided to TEA by phone and email during normal business hours.
 - b. Technical support will be provided to applicants by email.
5. TRC will develop and deliver summary reports for TEA that may include but are not limited to the following:
 - a. Spreadsheet of all applicants with pertinent contact information and other key fields as defined by TEA staff.
 - b. Spreadsheet summarizing all reviewer notes and evaluations.
6. TRC will make minor modifications to the application websites as necessary based on specific requests from TEA to improve functionality.
