AMENDMENT TO STANDARD CONTRACT BETWEEN TEXAS EDUCATION AGENCY AND

SAS Institute Inc.

It is mutually understood and agreed by and between the undersigned contracting parties of the above numbered contract to amend said contract effective 09/01/2014 as follows:

TEA is exercising the option to renew the Contract from <u>September 1, 2014 to August 31, 2015</u>. Add FY 2015 budget in the amount of \$1,290,000.00, decrease FY2014 budget in the amount of \$355,000.00 from: \$992,500.00 to \$637,500.00 for a new contract total of \$1,927,500.00, an increase of \$935,000.00.

Changes to fiscal year budget 11/21/2013 to 08/31/2014 of the contract revises task activity plan in the following way:

- Due to a compressed timeline tasks 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 in the task activity plan included in contract amendment #1 have been moved to contract year two. The total for these tasks is \$355,000.
- The remaining tasks and deliverables for contract year one are the annual licensing/system hardware/software configuration fee in the amount of \$637,500 and task 3 both of which have been completed and accepted by TEA.

Changes to fiscal year budget 09/01/2014 to 08/31/2015 of the contract revises task activity plan in the following way:

- Annual licensing fee to cover 65 pilot districts in the amount of \$600,567.
- The insertion and consolidation of what were Tasks 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 in the task activity plan included in contract amendment #1 as Tasks 3 through 7 in the contract year two task activity plan, in the amount of \$355,000.
- The insertion of what was optional Task 8, Roster Verification, in the original task activity plan into the year two
 task activity plan for a cost of \$334,433 for 65 pilot districts.

Revised Description of Services / Tasks & Activities and Budget documents attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Within the first twelve months of leaving employment at TEA, a former employee/retiree selected by the Contractor for employment or subcontracting, shall not perform services on a project or fill a position that the former employee/retiree worked on while employed at TEA.

Excluded Parties List System: The Texas Education Agency and the contractor must adhere to the directions provided in the President's Executive Order (EO) 13224, Blocking Property and Prohibiting Transactions With Persons Who Commit,

Threaten to Commit, or Support Terrorism. That Executive Order prohibits any transaction or dealing by United States persons, including but not limited to the making or receiving of any contribution of funds, goods, or services to or for the benefit of those persons listed in the General Services Administration's Excluded Parties List System (EPLS) which may be viewed on the System for Award Management (SAM) site at http://www.Sam.gov.

All other terms and conditions of the original contract remain the same and are incorporated herein as if specifically written.
