<ul> <li>Does not have to be a public meeting.</li> <li>Districts must notify all stakeholders of their ability to review the completed plan on the district website at least 30 days before the plan is submitted to the board of trustees.<sup>13</sup></li> <li>Stakeholder comments must be submitted to the Agency with the Turnaround Plan.<sup>14</sup></li> </ul>	The district, in consultation with the Campus Intervention Team	■ 2 <sup>nd</sup> year Overall F campuses (Not already implementing a Turnaround Plan)
