

Employed Principal Demographics 2011-2015

The table below presents the number of Principals employed in the Texas public school system, with breakdowns by gender and by race or ethnicity.

Overall results and gender

- The number of employed Principals increased over time.
- The number and percentage of female Principals increased in every academic year shown; percentage increases were small.
- Most Principals were female.

Race and ethnicity

- The ethnic breakdown was largely consistent over time.
- Most Principals were white; the second and third largest groups were Hispanic/Latino and black/African American Principals.
- The percentage of white Principals showed steady but very small declines.
- Percentages of black/African American and Hispanic/Latino Principals correspondingly increased.
- In academic year 2014-15, the number and percentage of Pacific Islanders increased markedly, but from very small baselines.

Summary of methodology. Five tables were extracted containing identification numbers, gender codes, and races or ethnicities of individuals employed as Principals in academic years 2010-11 through 2014-15. From each table, a total of all Principals was obtained. Sums by gender and race or ethnicity were then computed, and each sum was taken as a percentage of the total. Finally, all results were combined into one table.
