

GRE® revised General Test Score Bands to be used for Admission to an Educator Preparation Program under the 10% Exception Rule in 19 TAC §227.10(a)(3)(D)

An applicant who does not meet the minimum GPA requirement and is seeking certification in a class **other than classroom teacher** must perform at or above a score equivalent to a 2.5 GPA on the Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, and Analytic Writing sections of the GRE® (Graduate Record Examinations) revised General Test. The following scores shall be used for applicants seeking admission to educator preparation programs on or after December 27, 2106.
