# **High-Quality Prekindergarten Qualifications**

Curriculum

- Student progress monitoring
- Class ratio
- Teacher qualifications
- Family engagement
- Program evaluation





#### **STATUTE:**

Per <u>TEC Sec. 29.167(b)</u> Each teacher for a prekindergarten program class must:

(1) be certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21

#### **RULE:**

<u>19 TAC §102.1003 (f) (4)</u> In a format prescribed by the Texas Education Agency (TEA), a school district or an open-enrollment charter school shall: (4) Report additional teacher qualifications described in subsection (d) of this section

<u>19 TAC §102.1003 (d)</u> Each teacher of record in a high-quality prekindergarten program must be certified under the TEC, Chapter 21, Subchapter B, and have one of the following additional qualifications

### Teacher Qualifications for PK Teachers in a Contracted PK Classroom



HB 2729 includes guidance around contract entities: <u>(b-1) each teacher for a</u> <u>prekindergarten class provided by an entity</u> <u>with which a school district contracts to</u> <u>provide a prekindergarten program must:</u>

L) be supervised by a person

who meets the requirements

under Subsection (b); and

2) have one of the following qualifications:



#### **Requirements**

Each LEA prekindergarten teacher has a current Texas certification that enables them to teach prekindergarten OR a contracted prekindergarten teacher that is supervised by a prekindergarten teacher that meets all HQPK requirements

Each prekindergarten teacher meets one of the qualifications (as applicable per LEA teacher or contracted entity)

Each prekindergarten teacher's unique ID and qualifications are identified in ECDS annually

The LEA maintains the appropriate records to document compliance with this high-quality component


