...were being provided to ensure that they were meeting the needs of families and LEAs and that these supports were aligned and easily accessible. The development of the <u>Strategic Plan for Special Education in Texas</u> gave TEA the opportunity they needed to perform a comprehensive review of the networks and engage with various stakeholders on their effectiveness.

Through a competitive grant process, TEA division of special education program identified statewide leads to coordinate, develop, and disseminate technical assistance across the state. The areas for statewide leadership were determined through a review of existing support structures and extensive stakeholder engagement. Over the course of the 2019-2020 school year, these networks will create and disseminate a variety of guidance materials and resources for use by Education Service Centers (ESC) and Local Education Agencies (LEA) across the state.
