

Texas Education Agency Special Education Reading Academies Expert Group

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) in accordance with House Bill 3 has identified improving early literacy as a statewide priority. The state is designing and delivering statewide Reading Academies using the Science of Teaching Reading as a foundation to early reading instruction.
