Districts will generate a list of students with disabilities from all campuses, including JJAEPs, with enrolled student(s) that meet the "Criteria for Data Collection."

The LEA obtains the campus number for the JJAEP in the drop down menu in the SPP 13 application in TEASE/TEAL.

The LEA obtains a list of students enrolled on the JJAEP campus from their PEIMS personnel.
