

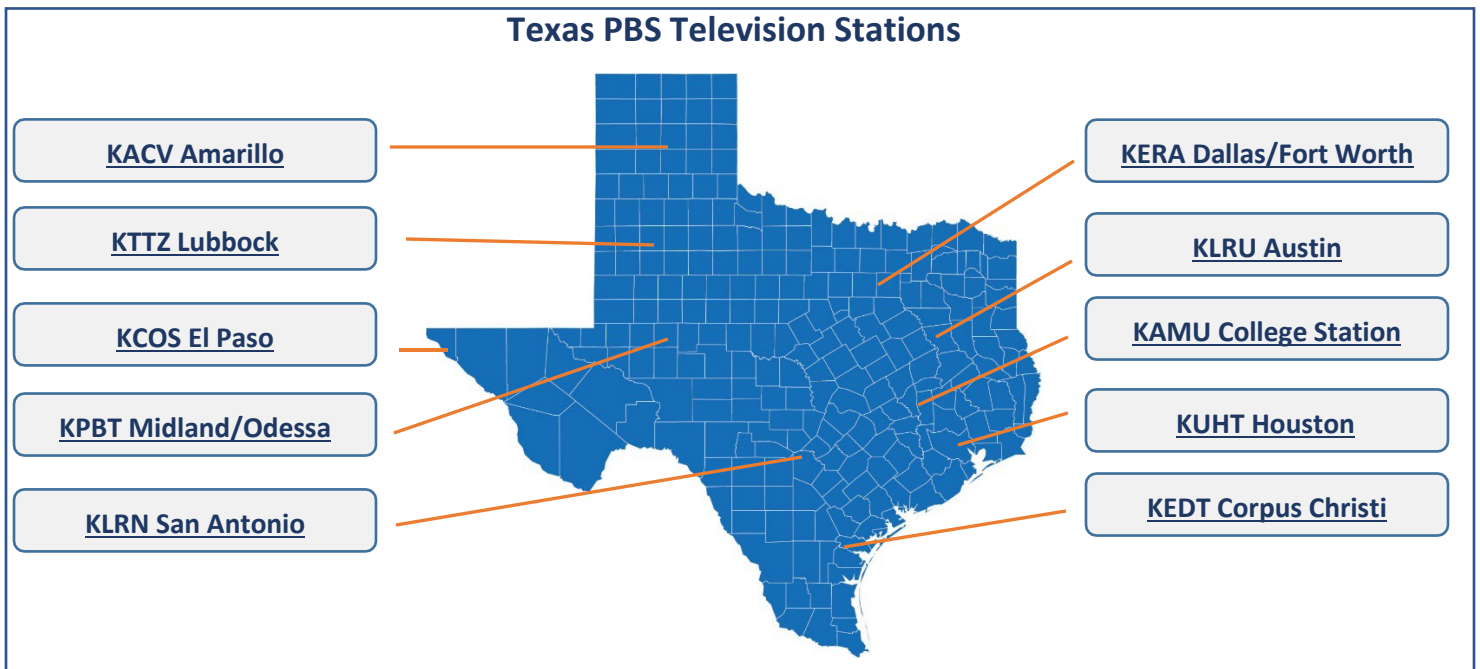


## TEA & PBS “At-Home Learning” Collaboration
