

- 2. Review and discuss with other Panel Experts (as needed) 3 5 minutes videos submitted by gifted/talented students enrolled in a Texas Public School or an Open Enrollment Charter.
- 3. Attend and/or view the Texas Performance Standards Project (TPSP) Assessment Rubric Review Session.
- 4. Provide written feedback to students that includes opportunities for growth.
- 5. Submit all assessment rubrics upon completion.
