Frequently Asked Questions

Introduction

1. Where can I find all the information about the Teacher Survey?

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) has created a webpage to be the center of information about the Teacher Survey. To find it from the [TEA homepage](#), find the icon “Texas Educators” click on Teacher Survey under Preparation and Continuing Education section. You may want to create a bookmark to access more easily the [Teacher Survey website](#).

2. What is this teacher survey about?

Teachers who have recently completed their educator preparation program (EPP) provide feedback about how well they were prepared.

3. Why am I being asked to participate?

You are being asked to participate because you have completed your first full year teaching on a standard teaching certificate. Since you have completed your EPP and have applied experience in the classroom, TEA needs your feedback about your preparation.

4. What will the survey be used for?

To ensure EPP accountability and to improve EPPs. To improve the educational experience for teacher candidates through EPPs.

5. Is there training for teachers with instructions for completing the surveys?

If so, how do I access it?

A Teacher Survey Training module is available on the [Teacher Survey website](#). The training module is presented in an on-demand format; you can view it at your convenience. In addition, you can print the documents for reference.

6. Is it possible to earn Continuing Professional Education (CPE) credit for completing the surveys?

Yes, the Texas Education Agency will award **10 CPE credit hours** for completing the teacher survey. Once the survey is submitted, you can download a CPE certificate to recognize your fulfillment of this requirement.

7. When is the teacher survey open?

Teachers will receive an e-mail with the survey link by **Wednesday, April 1, 2020**.

8. What do I need to do?

When you receive the e-mail, simply click on the link and take the survey.

9. Can I come back to complete the survey if I'm not able to complete right away?

Yes, you can complete the survey in more than one session, if needed.

10. Will the system automatically save if I do not complete the entire survey?

Yes, teachers may return later to complete and submit the survey. Everything entered will be saved and should be there upon returning to the survey.

11. When do I have to submit the surveys?

The deadline for submitting the Teacher Survey is **Monday, June 15, 2020 by 5:00 p.m.**
