# What is the TAPR?



- The agency released the first Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS) report for the 1990–91 school.
- The AEIS report published performance results by grade and subject area from the Texas Assessment of Academic Skills (TAAS) and later the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) for all campuses and districts in Texas.
- Information regarding attendance rates, graduation and dropout rates, college readiness, student and staff demographics, and district finances were also available through AEIS.



- The AEIS became the Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR) in 2013.
- The TAPR must include various data points as specified in <u>TEC §39.301</u>. Highlights include the following:
  - Performance on accountability indicators
  - State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) outcomes by specific student groups
  - Graduation plans
  - SAT, ACT, and workforce training program outcomes
  - Prior-year non-proficient student outcomes
  - Dual-language proficiency progress
  - Student profile information
  - Texas institution of higher education (IHE) outcomes



- Texas Student Data System Public Education Information Management System (TSDS PEIMS) is the source for TAPR data such as course completion, special programs, and demographic data.
- TSDS PEIMS is the legislatively mandated set of public education data, including student, staff, course, financial, and organizational information. Data is collected through electronic district submissions throughout the school year.
- Assessment data are provided by testing vendors such as Educational Testing Service (ETS), Pearson, ACT, Inc., College Board, and International Baccalaureate (IB).
- Postsecondary readiness and outcomes data are provided by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB).



# **TAPR Formats**



- The 2017–18 TAPR was expanded to two forms
  - an online data system, more comprehensive and dynamic than in previous years, and
  - a scaled back PDF version.
- The TAPR PDF includes only major data points and is designed to assist districts to fulfill their annual report requirements.
- The online data system publishes additional data not required in statute, such as kindergarten readiness, additional student group performance on STAAR, and postsecondary outcomes.

TAPR data are also available by <u>ESC region</u> and for the entire <u>state</u>.

<u>TAPR Glossary</u>, provides definitions, describes methodologies, and lists sources for each tab in the TAPR system.

TAPR Glosario, the Spanish translation of the glossary, will be available later this winter.



# What is the TAPR Data Download?



- The TAPR data download provides users the option to download data for all data elements within each section of the TAPR in an Excel, comma-delimited, or tab-delimited format.
- Once downloaded, users can manipulate the data using a spreadsheet or software program.
- Examples of software to manipulate TAPR data include: Microsoft Excel, Numbers for Mac, Open Office, Statistical Analysis System (SAS), Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), Tableau, or Microsoft Power BI.

- The first download option allows users to download sections from the TAPR PDF report into Excel, commadelimited, or tab-delimited format.
- This download option is best if users wish to download rate (percentage) information from the TAPR into a spreadsheet.



For example, the TAPR PDF lists STAAR performance by grade, subject area, and performance level. The data from this PDF can be downloaded for all districts, campuses, and ESCs in the state.

- The TAPR data download provides academic researchers, business leaders, and district leaders public access to longitudinal, student assessment datasets for scientific inquiry and policymaking purposes.
- Additionally, student and staff demographics provide school leaders with historical information for enrollment projections, facilities planning, and the potential impact of grade reconfigurations.



- Datasets from TAPR are frequently joined with spatial data from the agency's geographic information system (GIS) site to visualize assessment or demographics by school address or district attendance zone.

- Note that data on TAPR reports and the TAPR data download employ masking of performance data in order to comply with the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
- Generally, the term "masking" refers to the use of special symbols to conceal results and maintain student confidentiality.

- One method to "clean" a data download is to use the VLOOKUP function if viewing the TAPR data in Excel.
- VLOOKUP is an Excel function to reference and retrieve data from a specific column in table.
- This example will use the VLOOKUP function to "clean" the column headers from our previous Excel download.

# Visual Basic in Excel Demonstration



- Once the campus, district, or regional reference dataset has been downloaded, it can be "joined" with additional datasets such as STAAR, postsecondary readiness, or student demographic information.
- In order to join datasets, the common variable in each TAPR data download is the campus number or the district number, referred to as the CDN.
- For example, the six-digit CDN 227901 refers to Austin ISD. The ninedigit CDN 227901007 refers to Travis Early College High School in Austin ISD.



# Joining Datasets in Excel Demonstration



- TAPR data downloads are currently available for the 2018-19 school year. Additional TAPR reports and downloads are accessible from 2012-13 through 2017-18.
- As previously mentioned, the TAPR was known as the Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS) Reports. AEIS reports and corresponding data downloads are available from 2003–04 to 2011–12 on the AEIS Archive webpage, located at <u>https://rptsvr1.tea.texas.gov/perfreport/aeis/index.html</u>
