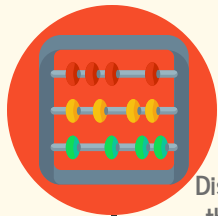


# Accountability System



Districts received A-F ratings under the new system. Campuses were evaluated using the A-F system but received Met Standard/Improvement Required ratings.

2017-18



Due to COVID-19 and the cancellation of STAAR, all districts and campuses were labeled Not Rated: Declared State of Disaster.

2019-20



Districts and campuses will receive A-C or Not Rated: Senate Bill 1365 ratings. Agency will release preliminary 2023 reset framework in May 2022.

2021-22



Districts and campuses will be evaluated under the updated A-F system.

2022-23

2016-17

A-F system developed using 2016-17 modeled data. This data was released to districts and was used as Year 1 Closing the Gaps data.



2018-19

Districts and campuses received A-F ratings.



2020-21

STAAR was administered. All districts and campuses received Not Rated: Declared State of Disaster ratings. Available accountability data, excluding ratings, were released publicly. Agency and stakeholder groups worked on accountability reset development.



2022

Summer 2022

Agency will process STAAR data and gather feedback on the reset framework.

Fall 2022

Agency will publish targets, cut points, and final 2023 reset framework.
